## AGREEMENT TO WAIVE PROFESSIONAL LAWN SERVICE

Under both Florida law (F.S. 83.52) and the Rental Agreement your responsibility as a tenant is to maintain the condition of a rental property at all times. By waiving professional lawn service, you are accepting the responsibilities that come with maintaining the lawn. You also shoulder the liabilities and the possibility of a claim on your security deposit in the event of damage to the lawn.

## Things to consider by waiving lawn maintenance:

- You will be responsible for the condition and maintenance of the lawn. You will be responsible for watering the lawn on a regular basis as stipulated by government regulations.
- The average cost to re-sod a lawn is \$1,600. And the average cost to water the new sod can be several hundred dollars.
- You may be subject to an administrative fee as high as \$250.00 for failing to properly maintain the lawn.
- You will be responsible for any damage caused by an unlicensed and/or uninsured vendor.
- You will be responsible for HOA violations and payment of fines for failure to maintain the law. You may be subject to admin strative fees if you receive an HOA violation

with the upkeep, maintenance, and any damage of the lawn, landscaping, and irrigation systems.
